0 – 500	Historique Colonisation européenne, introduction du fer, documents écrits
500 – 3 000	Sylvicole Sédentarisation, développement de la poterie et adoption du maïs
3 000 – 8 000	Archaïque Adaptations régionales, chasse aux cervidés et mammifères marins
8 000 – 12 000	Palé Indien Fin de l'ère glaciaire, peuplement du territoire, chasse à la mégafaune
