ACTIVITIES FOR ADULTS

Conferences with hands-on activity

Duration 60 min / max 30 participants / fee 150.00\$ + taxes

Interactive presentation where participants can handle artifact reproductions and learn about the traditional life of aboriginal people. *Also available as a virtual live presentation.*

Choice of subjects:

- Aboriginal peoples in Quebec: history and lifeways
- Plants fibers: ordinary plants with extraordinary uses
- Bone work in the pre-contact period: doing much with little
- Wood work from the past to the present: traditions and innovations
- Stone work in the pre-contact period: from axe to arrow
- Dugout canoe project: the experimental crafting of a prehistoric boat

Conferences with work demonstration

Duration 90 min / max 30 participants / fee 200.00\$ + taxes

Interactive presentation where participants can handle artifact reproductions and observe traditional crafting techniques.

Choice of subjects:

- Plant fibers: the secrets of weeds. Making a tumpline
- Deer bones: a forgotten treasure. Making a sewing tool
- Wood work: techniques to rediscover. Making a pin and ring toy
- Stone tools: a sophisticated technology. Making a projectile point
- Fishing techniques: from line to net. Making a net
- Hunting techniques: from spear to bow. Making a bow

Conferences with craft workshop

Duration 120 min / max 30 participants / fee 250.00\$ + taxes

Interactive presentation where participants can handle artifact reproductions and experiment making a traditional object with the craftsman. Material included.

Choice of subjects:

- Plant fibre cordage
- Sinew fibre cordage **NEW**
- Fish hook
- Polished stone point
- Flint knapping (max 15 participants) **NEW**
- Bone needle (max 15 participants) **NEW**
- Pottery
- Stone bead jewelry **NEW**
